A person has a right to a home, nobody should be forced onto the streets.

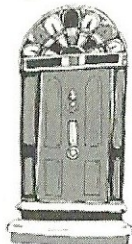

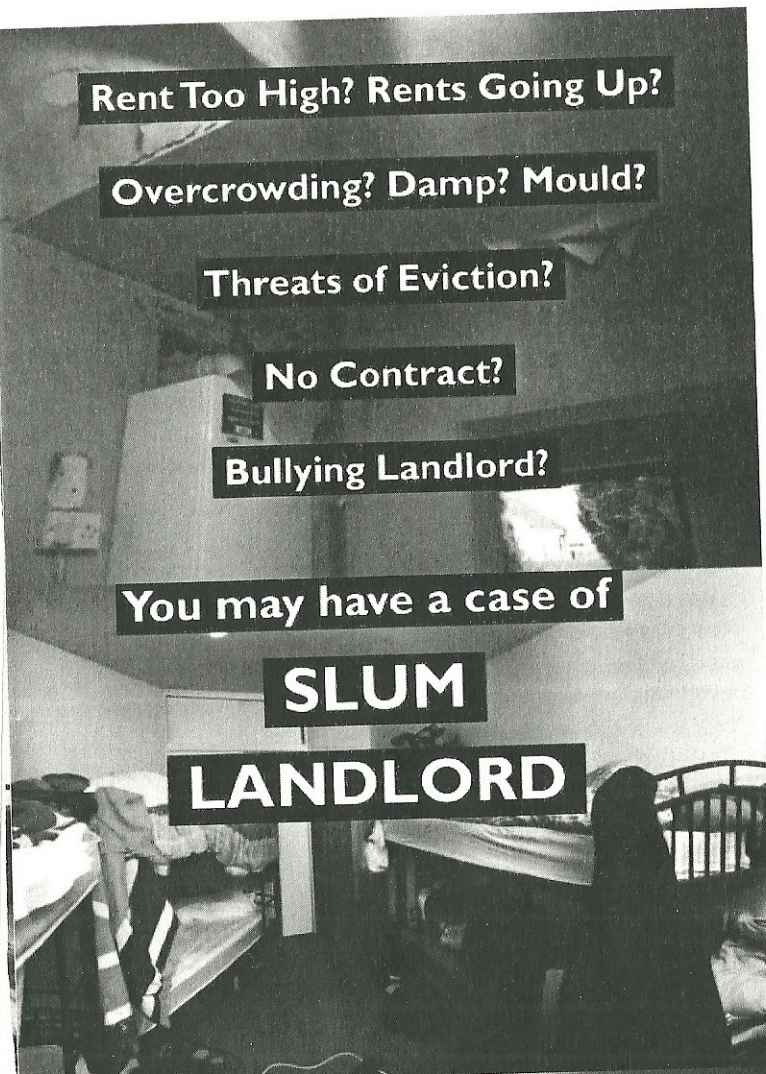
