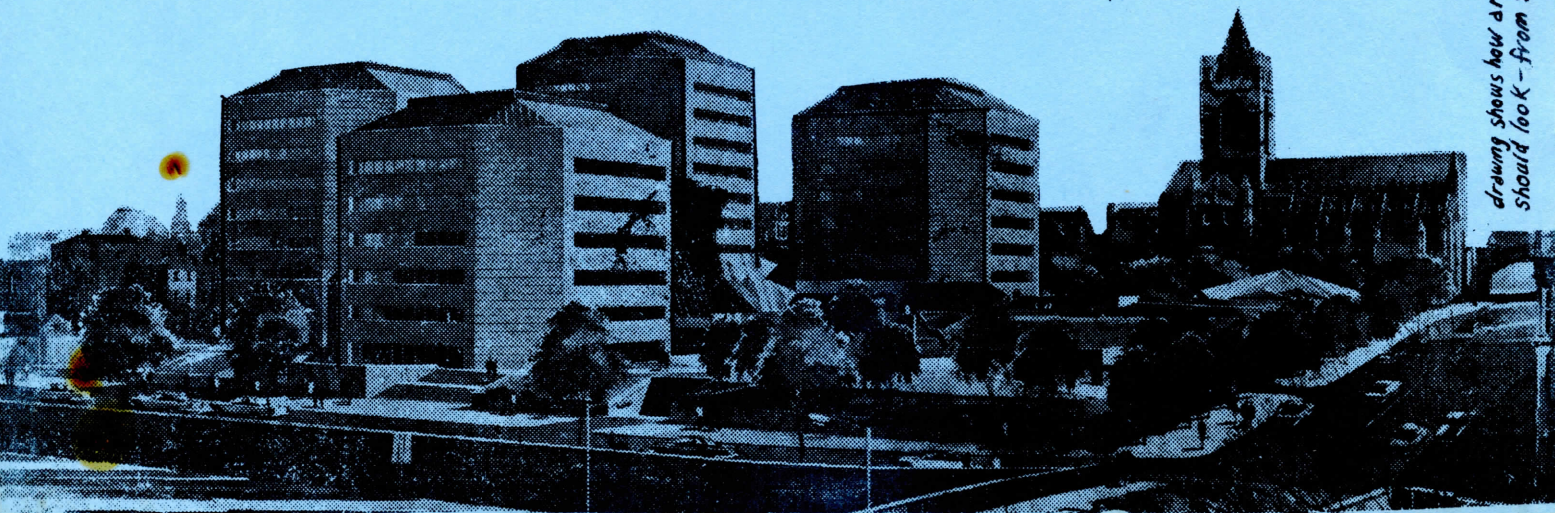


Wood Quay is an election issue

- 4 Use Wood Quay site for inner city renewal

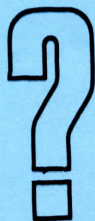

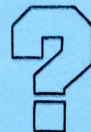
