Cllr. Ted Tynan, President of the Workers' Party has condemned shameful government inaction for allowing the continuing obscene profiteering by energy companies on the back of young and old facing choices of food or electricity in the coming winter. Nationalisation of energy companies is urgently needed in order to restore control of an essential asset and secure the welfare of households.

SSE Airtricity is the latest to announce whopping price rises, raising electricity bills by 35% and gas 39%. This is despite their boast that their energy sources are 100% green. Justification for these increases is highly questionable and the company is unashamedly following other energy companies taking advantage of the current fuel supply crisis to rake in obscene profits. SSE parent company earlier reported over a billion pounds sterling in profit.

The disgraceful contrast is the growing fuel poverty of households which the ESRI puts at 29 per cent and rising. The elderly are obviously going to suffer but children are also vulnerable. The threat to health and lives is such that a Belfast consultant paediatrician is 'concerned that children will die this winter' and she is 'praying for a mild winter.'
