Apartheid in the West Bank

Palestinians in the West Bank have suffered under harsh Israeli military law since 1967. They endure home demolitions, seizure of land, movement restrictions, imprisonment without trial, attacks by settlers, and violence and humiliation at Israeli military checkpoints.

Meanwhile, Israel's illegal settlers are protected under Israeli civil law.



Gaza - 16 Years Under Siege

As well as repeated military onslaughts, which Israeli leaders have described as "mowing the lawn", Israel has imposed a cruel 16-year siege on the 2-million population of the Gaza Strip as a collective punishment for their democratic choice.



Apartheid in the Israeli State

Over 50 different laws discriminate against Palestinian citizens of the Israeli state. The "Law of Return" (1950) offers automatic citizenship to Jewish people worldwide, even if they have never set foot in the region.

The "Prevention of Infiltration Law" (1954) prevents Palestinian refugees from exercising their UN-mandated Right of Return to their homeland. This ensures an artificial Jewish-Israeli majority by forcibly excluding indigenous Palestinians.



Apartheid - A Crime Against Humanity

The International Criminal Court's 2002 Rome Statute defines apartheid as:

"inhumane acts... committed in the context of an institutionalized regime of systematic oppression and domination by one racial group over any other racial group or groups and committed with the intention of maintaining that regime."

Numerous human rights bodies, including Amnesty International, Human Rights Watch and the Israeli organisation B'Tselem, have agreed that Israel is guilty of apartheid.
