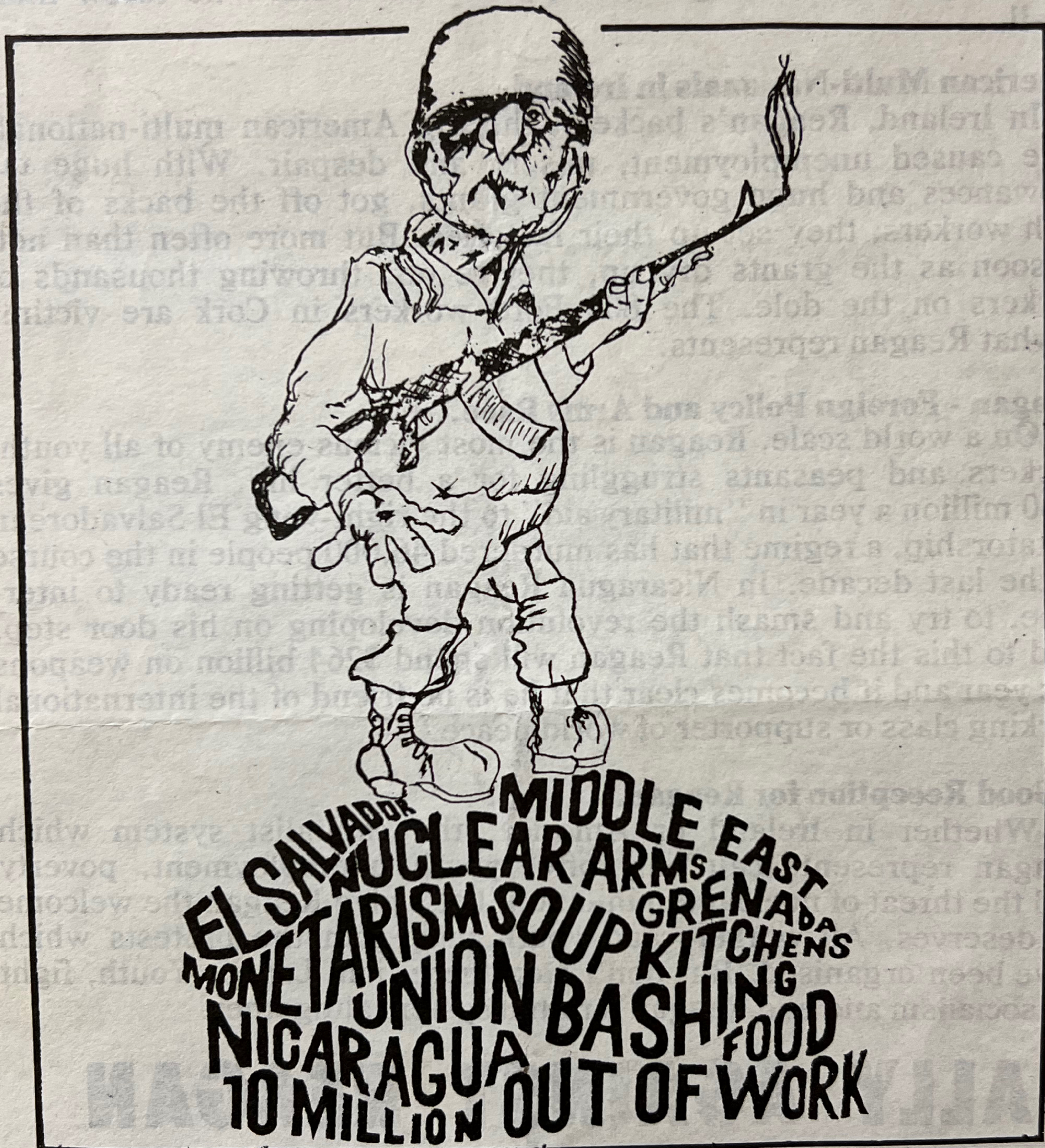


# Not wanted

### **Reagan - An Enemy of Trade Unionism.**

Ronald Reagan is an enemy of the trade union movement. He was responsible for sacking 12,000 air traffic controllers in 1981 and banned their union PATCO rather than negotiate. When the workers protested, Reagan's response was brutal - he threw them in jail.

### **American Multi-Nationals in Ireland.**

In Ireland, Reagan's backers, the big American multi-nationals have caused unemployment, misery and despair. With huge tax allowances and huge government grants, got off the backs of the Irish workers, they set up their factories. But more often than not, as soon as the grants dry up, they're off, throwing thousands of workers on the dole. The 800 Ford workers in Cork are victims of what Reagan represents.

### **Reagan - Foreign Policy and Arms Race.**

On a world scale, Reagan is the most vicious enemy of all youth, workers and peasants struggling for a better life. Reagan gives \$160 million a year in "military aid" to the right-wing El Salvadorean dictatorship, a regime that has murdered 46,000 people in the course of the last decade. In Nicaragua Reagan is getting ready to intervene, to try and smash the revolution developing on his door step. Add to this the fact that Reagan will spend \$264 billion on weapons this year and it becomes clear that he is no friend of the international working class or supporter of world peace.

### **A Good Reception for Reagan.**

Whether in Ireland or America, the capitalist system which Reagan represents can only offer youth unemployment, poverty and the threat of nuclear annihilation. Let's give Reagan the welcome he deserves. All workers and youth must join the protests which have been organised. But don't stop there, join Labour Youth, fight for socialism and end Reagan's rotten system altogether.
