What is the solution in the Middle East?

There is no "peace process" in the Middle East. Violence and hardship have been a constant feature. The Israeli State talks of peace but at the same time settlements are extended.

The ground is being prepared for another war. A regional war in the Middle East will be bloody and a disaster for the ordinary people of the area. The main agency of the conflict is the Israeli State and the establishment it defends.

This meeting is an eyewitness account of what is going on in the area by an activist who has visited it a number of times including recently.

The situation is not as we are told in the media. Not only does the Israeli State oppress Palestinians but also working class Jews.

There is no solution to the problems of the area on the basis of corrupt Israeli or Arab capitalism, which offers nothing but a future of poverty and violence. Conditions in the Palestinian state are terrible. The last years have also seen a real division open up inside Israel between the rich and ordinary people who have felt the brunt of economic crisis. In very difficult conditions, an opportunity for a class opposition to these corrupt regimes is emerging. Come along to hear more.
